



Tour #5 = Billy Graham Library & Asheville (5 days)

Day 1 = Trinity Episcopal Church, Woodrow Wilson Presidential Library
Staunton, VA - Trinity Episcopal Church. Featuring more than a dozen Tiffany stained glass windows and a Taylor & Boody pipe organ, this Neo-Gothic masterpiece was built in 1855.

Staunton, VA - Woodrow Wilson Presidential Library. Explore the life of one of America's most influential presidents. Immerse yourself in the World War I trench exhibit, take a peek at Wilson's Pierce Arrow limousine, walk the halls in the house where he was born, and learn more about what makes him a consequential and controversial president.

Day 2 = Billy Graham Library, Lazy 5 Ranch
Charlotte, NC - The Billy Graham Library. This 40,000-square-foot multimedia experience shares the remarkable ways God used a dairy farmer's son to tell the world about His love. Designed to tell the life-giving message of Jesus Christ, this beautiful barn shaped building is situated on 20 landscaped acres, only miles from where Billy Graham grew up.

Mooreville, NC - Lazy 5 Ranch. Hop aboard your horse-drawn wagon and enjoy up-close and personal encounters with more than 750 exotic animals from six continents on 185 acres! Animals include cattle, deer, elk, antelope, sheep, goats, potbelly pigs, kangaroos, camels, llamas, giraffes, and more!



Day 3 = Biltmore Estate, Downtown Asheville

Asheville, NC - One of the most prominent examples of Gilded Age architecture, the Biltmore House was built for George Washington Vanderbilt II between 1889 and 1895 and is the largest privately owned house in the United States. After exploring Biltmore, enjoy free time in **Downtown Asheville**, where you can browse the many unique shops and pick the perfect place for dinner!



Day 4 = Billy Graham Training Center at the Cove

Asheville, NC - In 1988, after much prayer, Billy and Ruth Graham first founded this retreat center only 15 miles away from their home in Montreat. "We want the Cove to be a place where people come to know God in a deep and life-changing way through the study of the Scriptures," Billy Graham explained during the dedication service.



This 1,200 acre retreat, conference, and training center located in the beautiful Blue Ridge Mountains provides a place for rest, renewal, inspiration, and instruction.



Your one hour tour includes: The Eckerd Seminar Room (featuring a short film about the Cove), the Billy Graham Pictorial Display, the Chapel, and the Prayer Room. Adjacent to the Chapel, Ruth's Prayer Garden is designed to offer a peaceful place for prayer and meditation amid the natural beauty and serenity of the Cove.

Day 5 = Thomas Jefferson's Monticello, James Madison's Montpelier

Charlottesville, VA - Explore the fascinating stories of Thomas Jefferson - the author of the Declaration of Independence, the third president of the United States, and the founder of the University of Virginia.
