





## FAQs

**Must we be a church group?** Nope! Although JCJ is designed for church groups, any group of 8-10 people may enjoy a JCJ Small Group Tour! (family members, friends, coworkers, etc.) The daily prayer and devotional time is a regular part of the JCJ experience regardless of the nature of the group.

**Can our group be from more than one church?** Absolutely, but please have only one point person with whom Jeff can communicate.

**What if we have more than 10 people?** Our custom van has seating for only 10 guests. Jeff is happy to provide a second tour if desired.

**Is there an age limit for a Small Group Tour?** No, although JCJ is designed for adults and teens. Please note that some tour destinations may have limited appeal to younger age groups and that you must be 13 years old or older to serve in an OCC Processing Center (Small Group Tours 7 and 9).

**Is there an age limit for an Open Tour?** Yes, all guests on an Open Tour must be at least 18 years old.

**Is food allowed in the van?** Yes. Snacks and water will be provided, and you are welcome to bring your own food and drinks as well. Please be mindful of others in the van, and alcohol is prohibited.

**Is there a restroom in the van?** No. Rest stops are planned every two hours or so as we travel. If you need to stop sooner, no problem at all, just let Jeff know.

- Accepted forms of payment are debit cards, credit cards, checks, PayPal, and Zelle.
- Final payment is due 45 days before departure.
- A Final Details packet will be mailed to each guest approximately 2 weeks prior to departure. The packet will contain final details, a final schedule, and Tour Director gratuity envelopes.
- Jeff's Christian Journeys reserves the right to cancel a tour if the minimum number of 8 guests has not been reached 45 days before departure. Full refunds will be provided.
- To avoid a possible cancellation due to low registration numbers, each open spot below 8 will result in a charge. (\$150 per open spot for multiple-day tours, and 50% of the total cost per open spot for single-day tours.)
- If a guest needs to cancel their tour for any reason, the following refund policy will apply. 45+ days prior to departure = full refund. 31-44 days prior to departure = 75% refund. 16-30 days prior to departure = 50% refund. 15 days or less prior to departure = no refund.
- If a roommate cancels 45+ days prior to departure, the remaining person(s) will be charged the applicable accommodation rate for the number of persons occupying the room.
