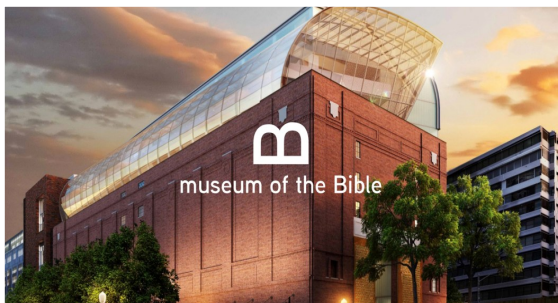

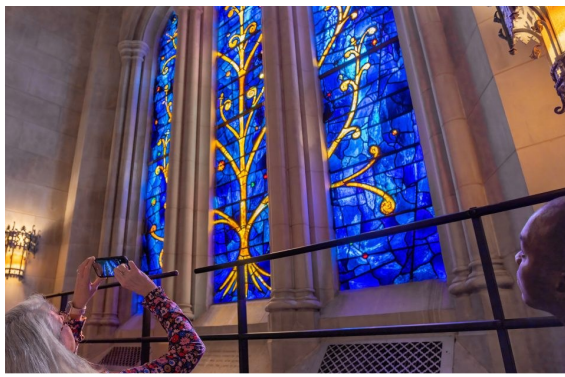

Open Tour A (2 days) - Anyone can join! (Oct. 15-16, 2026)

- Each day will feature a brief prayer and devotional time in the van.
- The tour schedule may change due to weather and traffic conditions.
- A \$100 deposit and a completed registration are required to sign up for the tour.
- Final payment is due on August 31, 2026. (45 days before departure)
- Accepted forms of payment are debit cards, credit cards, checks, PayPal, and Zelle.
- Debit card, credit card, and PayPal payments have a 3.49% processing fee.
- Check and Zelle payments have no processing fee.
- A Final Details packet will be mailed to each guest approximately 2 weeks prior to departure. The packet will contain final details, a final schedule, and Tour Director gratuity envelopes.
- Jeff's Christian Journeys reserves the right to cancel a tour if the minimum number of 8 guests has not been reached 45 days before departure. Full refunds will be provided.
- If a guest needs to cancel their tour for any reason, the following refund policy will apply.
45+ days prior to departure = full refund. 31-44 days prior to departure = 75% refund. 16-30 days prior to departure = 50% refund. 15 days or less prior to departure = no refund.
- If a roommate cancels 45+ days prior to departure, the remaining person(s) will be charged the applicable accommodation rate for the number of persons occupying the room.
- A 5'x8' enclosed trailer will be used for luggage. Items desired while traveling in the van should not be packed in your luggage.
- Unless noted, gratuities are not included. (Housekeeping, Restaurant, Tour Director)
